Hybrid Program

The new program is meant to encourage parents to continue to be the primary formators of their children's faith. While the lessons are completed in class, they should be reiterated by parents at home. I suggest doing this by rewatching the Blessed Program videos at home. We hope with a new every-other-week schedule, families feel supported in their role while their children feel that they are part of the parish community. As always, the foremost ways to lead your family by faith are through weekly Mass attendance and daily prayer in the home.

Class Days

All children will meet in the Parish Center on their scheduled days and be brought to their classroom by their catechist. Children should bring their workbook with them each time we have class. They will be labeled just in case a child misplaces theirs. Parents are asked to arrive a few minutes early for class and come into the Parish Center at both drop-off and pick-up in order that all the children are safely checked-in and dismissed on time.
