FAQs

Who is eligible to participate?

Any young person entering 9th grade this Fall through 2021 High School graduates are eligible to attend this conference.

Where will youth & adult participants be sleeping?

There will be two separate areas of the parking lot assigned for men and women sleeping areas. Youth will be responsible for bringing their own overnight “bed” whether that be a tent, sleeping bag, airbed, etc. Chaperones will sleep on the perimeter of the male and female sleeping areas.

Will there be overnight security?

Yes, we will have adult volunteers (Men of Saint Joseph) on watch throughout the evening while participants sleep. We will also coordinate with Smithfield Police Department.

What is the restroom situation?

Each sleeping area will have large portable bathrooms. Each area will also have a portable handwashing sink. Upon arrival, youth will receive an individual care package which will include 2 mini-bottles of water for Friday evening and Saturday morning teeth brushing.

Are the t-shirts for the conference weekend?

Yes, we hope that all participants will wear the conference t-shirt on Saturday. T-shirts will be distributed upon arrival Friday night.

Why is our deposit non-refundable?

We are requesting a non-refundable deposit of \$75 per participant upon registration. We are in the process of booking our caterers/food trucks, speakers, audio/visual, band and more. Our needs will be determined as we receive registrations and be committed to paying for these services.

Will we be able to adjust our numbers after submitting our registration?

Yes, as available. As long as we have capacity, you can add participants to your reservation. Once you have registered for your group number, you are responsible for paying the final balance of \$125 per participant who is attending by Friday, July 2nd. **As of July 2nd all registrations need to be paid in full and are final.**

What are the Covid safety protocols?

We will be following the State of RI Mandates for Covid. As of May 28th masks are required if less than 3 feet social distancing outside. As of right now we will wear masks under the tent but will continue to monitor and make decisions based on guidelines as they are given by the State of RI.
